Prescription Changes

Come April 1st 2023, the NHS
Prescription Charge will increase
to £9.65 per prescription item.
The cost of PPCs has also
increased, with the price of a
three-month PCC at £31.25 (an
increase of £1.00) and a 12month PPC at £111.60 (an
increase of £3.50). PPCs offer
savings for those needing four or
more items in three months, or
12 or more items in a year.

A recent announcement of Hormone Replacement Therapy PPC has come into place and will cost £19.30 (the cost of two prescription charges). This prescription prepayment certificate is valid for a 12-month period and can be used against any listed HRT prescription item(s) licensed for the treatment of menopause.

Antibiotics Usage & Resistance



Antibiotics are used to treat or prevent some types of bacterial infection. However, many mild bacterial infections get better on their own without using antibiotics. They are not effective against viral infections, such as the common cold or flu.

Antibiotics are sometimes given as a precaution to prevent, rather than treat an infection.

Antibiotics are **no longer routinely used to treat infections**, as many infections are caused by viruses, and **therefore antibiotics are not effective**.

The **more** antibiotics are used to treat **trivial conditions**, the more likely they are to be **ineffective** for treating **more serious conditions**.

Please see link attached which explains why antibiotics **do not work** on viral infections. If it important to note that the overuse of antibiotics leads to them becoming less effective and has led to the emergence of **'superbugs'** which have developed resistance to many antibiotics.
